The German university system is highly international. More than 400.000 international students study in Germany in BA- or MA-programs or undertake PhD-research, making Germany one of the most important destinations for international students world-wide. Germany is top choice, famously strong in engineering, science and technology programs and well affordable as public universities charge no or low tuition fees. Germany strives to internationalize even more, the government is highly interested to attract more international students. Germany is a reliable partner with transparent and stable regulations.

German universities offer about **2.400 degree programs entirely taught in English**. Among these are

- 430 BA programs
- 1.950 MA programs.
- In addition, in most subjects, is it largely possible to do a PhD in English in Germany.

by choosing English as the course language (in 'more filters').

At 'Course of studies' you can narrow the search down to e.g. engineering programs and further to different subfields of engineering.

If you click on a course you get more information on duration, admission, beginning, tuition fees etc.

German Higher Education system is largely dominated by public universities which do charge no or comparably low tuition fees. However, there are also some private universities who do charge tuition fees.
